

INFORMATION PACK Staffordshire ASA Championships 2022 Weekend 2

This pack contains important information that will be enforced during the remaining two days of the championships. Please ensure athletes, coaches and support staff know about this latest information.

The Government are relaxing Covid restrictions but as an organisation we remain committed to ensuring a safe environment for all concerned. It is important to note that a number of officials remain concerned, and we would ask all to keep this in mind. Events of this nature cannot operate with out officials and insufficient numbers could invalidate the license for the meet. So please respect their space.

This weekend requirements:

- There is no spectating at the Championships keeping it consistent to the previous weekend.
- There is no requirement to show a lateral flow test but there is a requirement to register your attendance.
- Do not attend the venue if you have any of the symptoms of COVID or are generally unwell.
- It is not compulsory to wear a face covering, it is now a choice.
- Social distancing is expected.
- The end of the pool will not be used by swimmers or coaches.
- Bring and use your hand sanitiser regularly.
- Changing rooms are for changing not meeting friends or playing games.
- Teams to use their allocated area.
- One way system. Keep left of stairway. Anticlockwise around pool deck.
- Access to the timing suite is not permitted.
- Teams allocated on the balcony Must be dry when going up the stairs and wearing tee shirt and footwear.
- Coaches to ensure they have contact details of their athletes' parents and/or guardians along with any necessary medical alerts on their athletes.
