

## Staffordshire ASA (Affiliated to ASA West Midlands Region) Staffordshire Masters 2022 Incl. 15/17, 18/24 Senior Open Meet (Including Staffordshire Masters Championships)



Held under ASA Law & Technical Rules Saturday April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022 – Stafford Leisure Centre, Stafford

## Promoter's conditions

- 1. The promoter of this competition is Staffordshire ASA
- 2. The closing date for entries is Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at Midnight
- 3. All competitors must be registered with the ASA and have completed an entry form in full
- 4. Poolside entries will not be accepted, nor will entries after the closing date
- 5. There is no restriction on the number of events a swimmer may enter
- 6. Fees will be £6.50 per individual event and £13.00 per team event
- 7. Warm up starts 45 minutes before the commencement of each session
- 8. There will be award for the top three places in each age in each event, no presentations will take place
- 9. Anything not covered in these conditions will be at the discretion of the promoter
- 10. Age groups will be 15/17, 18/24, 25/29 & in 5-year age bands as necessary, there is no upper age band
- 11. Age is at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022. In the 15/17 age group, swimmers must also be a minimum age of 15 on the day of the competition
- 12. Masters age groups in relays 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+, 280+. All swimmers must be over 25 years
- 13. The age group relays will be 60+and 100+. All swimmers must be over the age of 15
- 14. Relay declaration forms MUST be handed in to the promotor 60 minutes before the start of each session
- 15. A swimmer may compete for one club only
- 16. Depending on the number of swimmers, the promotor has the rights change the number of lanes used for each event
- 17. Entries with no times entered will be swum in the slowest heats and relays will be organised into age bands using the minimum number of heats
- 18. Acceptance of entries will be posted on the Staffordshire ASA website one week prior to the event
- 19. It is your responsibility to check the details and query any discrepancies before 18th April 2022
- 20. No programs will be on sale during the event. Programs will be available to download from the Staffordshire ASA website prior to the event and starts lists will be available to download the day before the event
- 21. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation Stafford Leisure Centre. No member of Staffordshire ASA, its officers or the promotor of this event will be liable for any loss, damage or injury occurring during this event
- 22. Athletes, volunteers, and officials will follow the guidance of the Welfare Officer and the Covid Liaison Officer. Anyone failing to do so may be excluded from the competition.

## Staffordshire Championships

- 1. Open to swimmers who are members of, and competing for clubs affiliated to Staffordshire ASA and have not represented and other county or competed in any other county championship in the previous year
- 2. The above promoter conditions apply
- 3. An award will be presented to first place only
- 4. The Staffordshire swimmers will be integrated and take part in the open meet and will be eligible for awards as an open meet swimmer.
